





Parts of Speech

NOUN

Name of a person, place, thing or idea.

Examples: Daniel, London, table, hope
 Mary uses a blue pen for her notes.

ADJECTIVE

Describes, modifies or gives more information about a noun or pronoun.

Examples: cold, happy, young, two, fun
- The little girl has a pink hat.

ADVERB

Modifies a verb, an adjective or another adverb. It tells how (often), where, when.

Examples: slowly, very, always, well, too - Yesterday, I ate my lunch quickly.

PRONOUN

A pronoun is used in place of a noun or noun phrase to avoid repetition.

Examples: I, you, it, we, us, them, those

- I want her to dance with me.

VERB

Shows an action or a state of being.

Examples: go, speak, eat, live, are, is

- I listen to the word and then repeat it.

PREPOSITION

Shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to another word.

Examples: at, on, in, from, with, about - I left my keys *on* the table *for* you.
