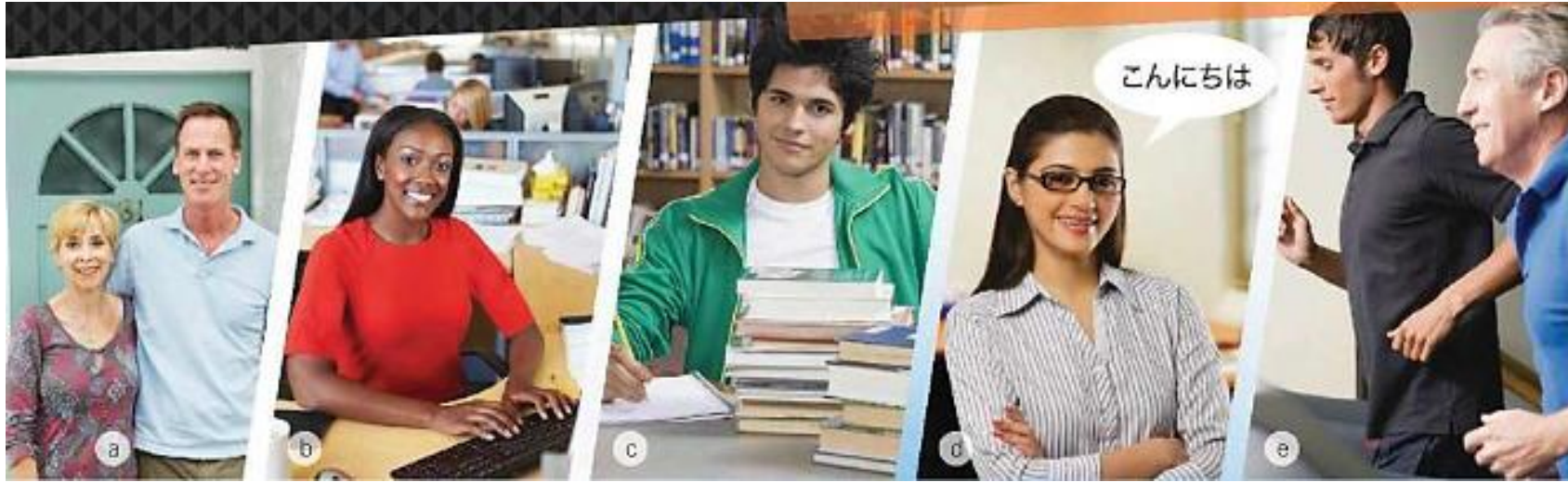

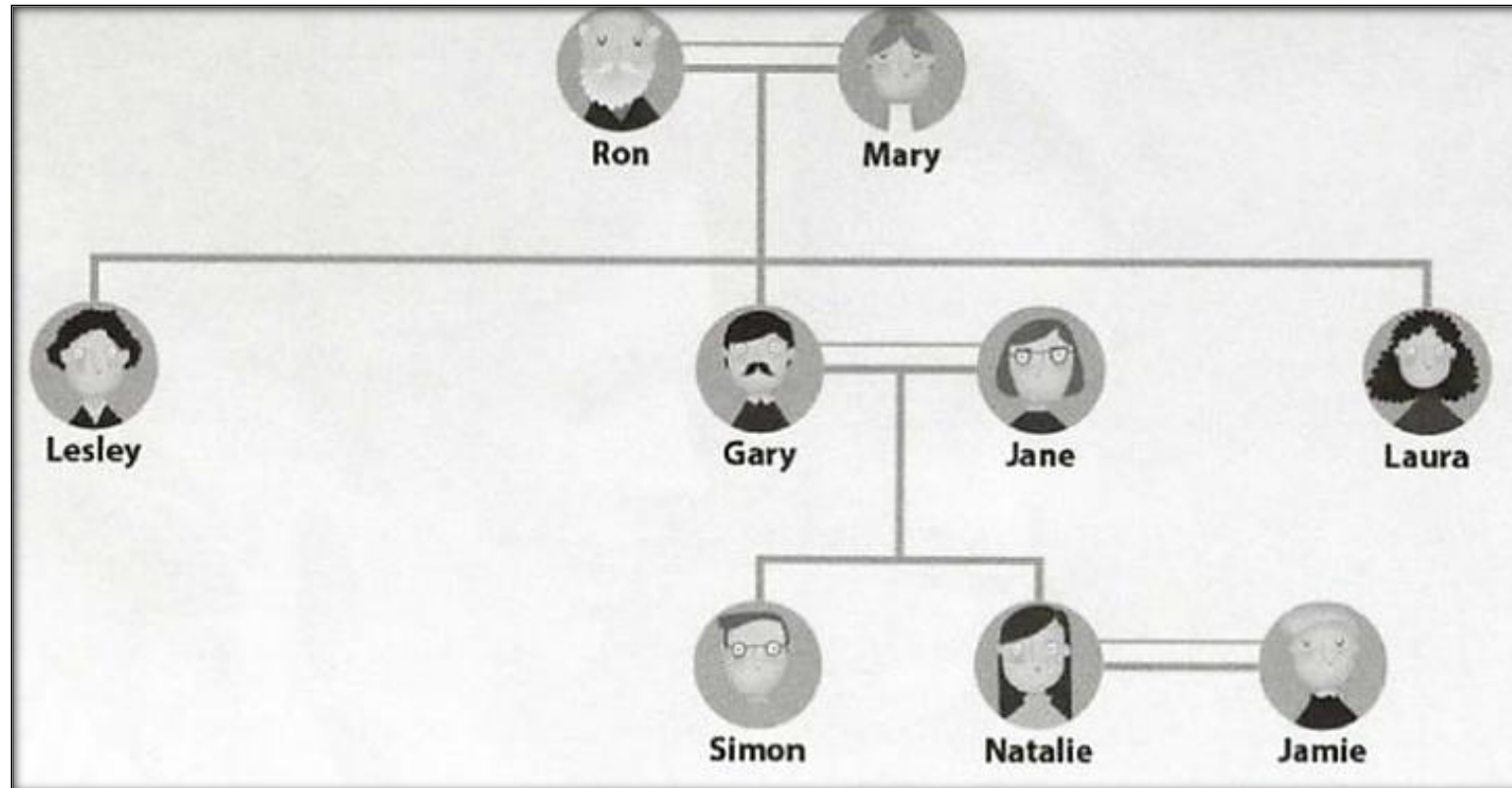

### Singular and Plural verbs

Singular subjects use plural verbs:

**Subject** verb

The girl walks.

Plural subjects use singular verbs:

**Subject** verb

The girls walk.

Personal pronouns + **verbs to be** (am/is/are)

I	am	
Singular	verb = <b>cry</b>	
She	is	cries
He	is	cries
It	is	cries

Plural

They	cry
We	cry
You	cry

### VOWELS - A, E, I, O, U

1. Most words are made plural by adding **-s**.

eat- eats, run-runs, like-likes, house - houses

1. If a word ends in **-s**, **-sh**, **-ch**, **-x**, or **-z**, you add **-es**.

Bus – buses

brush – brushes

Church – churches

Box – boxes

Buzz - buzzes

1. Many nouns that end in **-y** are made plural by replacing the **-y** with **-ies**. BUT—If there is a vowel before the **-y**, then it is made plural the regular way, by adding **-s** to the end of the word.

Play - plays

Boy - boys

Toy - toys

Story - stories

Baby – babies

City - cities

1. Many nouns that end in **-f** OR **-fe** are made plural by replacing the **-f** with **-ves**. BUT—If there is a vowel before the **f**, then it is made plural the regular way, by adding **-s** to the end of the word.

chef – chefs

calf- calves

thief – thieves

wife – wives

Foot - feet, child – children, person – people

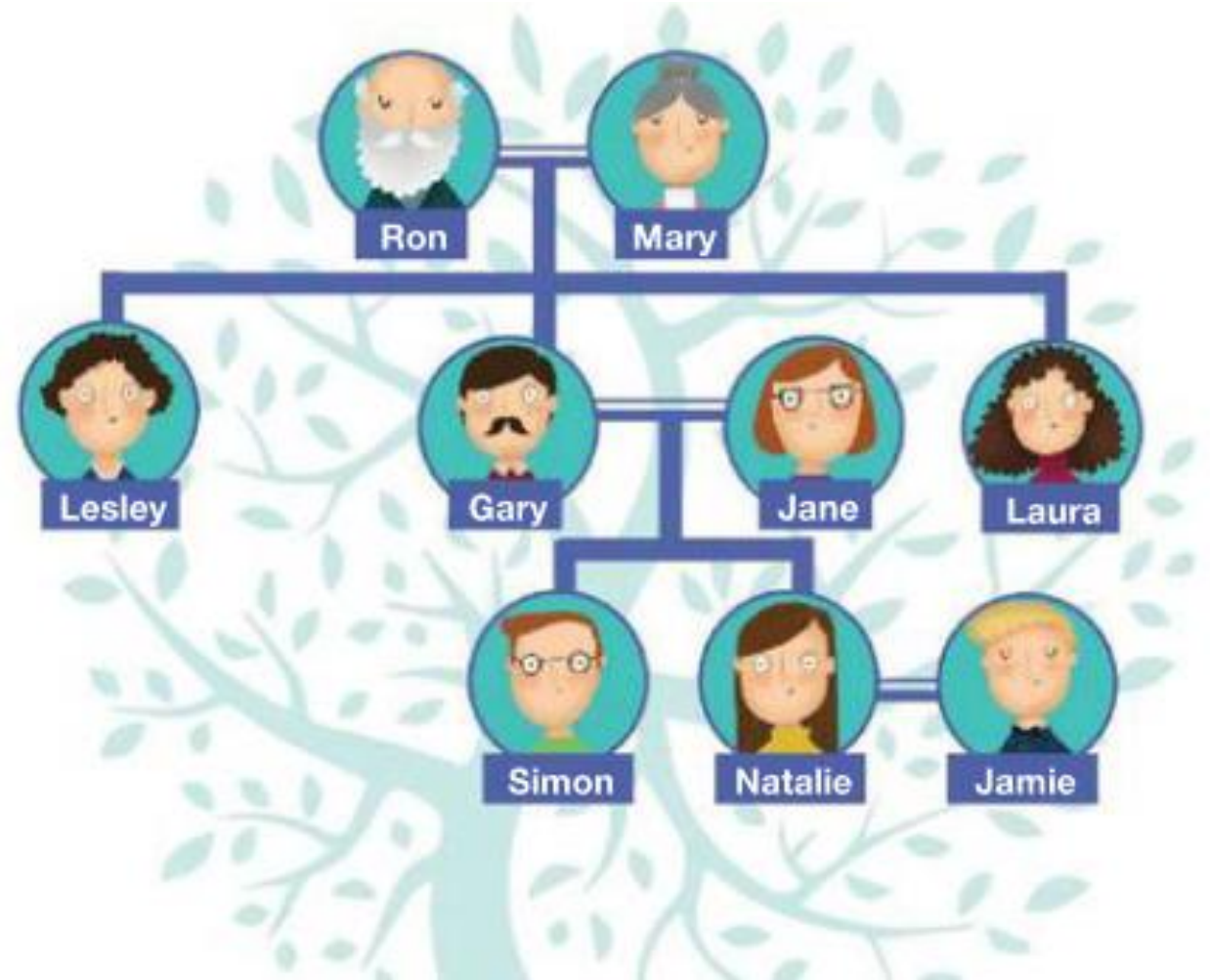
