1. Planning

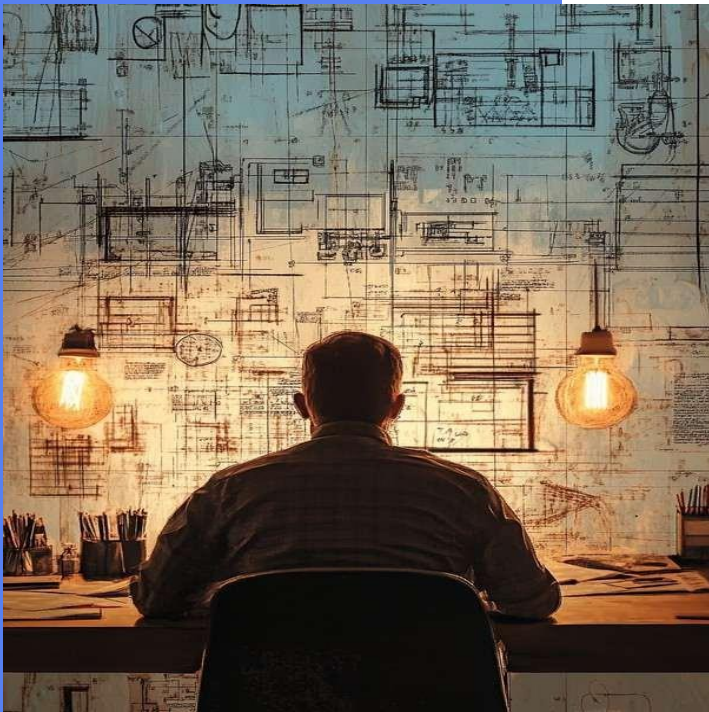
The first function of management, focusing on setting objectives and determining a course of action.

2. Organizing

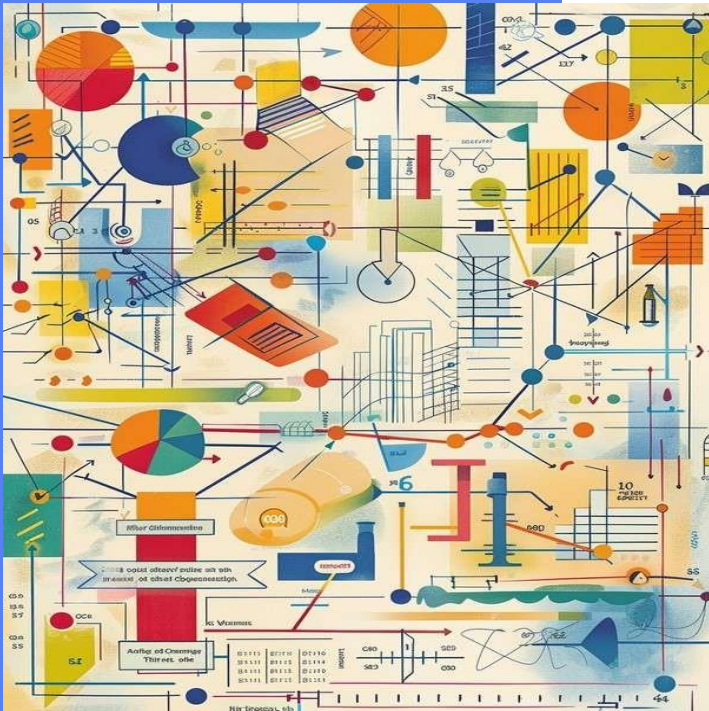
The management function that involves arranging resources to carry out the company's plans.

Organizational Structure



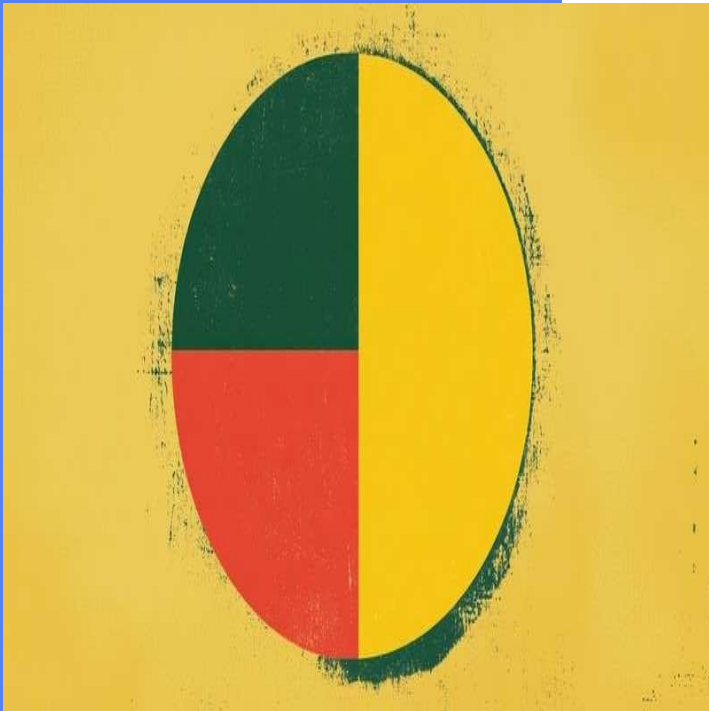
- 1.** Organizational structure outlines how activities are directed to achieve goals.
